**Tip of the Month – How can I export my ACE Charts?**

Now that you can create charts in ACE, you may also want to incorporate these into your estimate documentation and/or presentation. Previously, this capability was available only from POST; now you can also export these charts from ACE.

Open the chart dialog by selecting Reports > View Charts or by clicking the toolbar icon ( ). These options are available from either the ACE workscreen or the Inputs/Results Viewer. Once the dialog is open, charts can be customized. Select the chart type from the **Display** tab. The **Calculation** tab allows you to select what-if cases, type of dollars (BY, TY, SY), year range and RISK calculation options. The **Data** tab lets you drill down your WBS and show more or less information on the chart. You can also filter and summarize by category.

To export this chart, click the **Export** icon.



Click OK to save the chart; the Export wizard opens to guide you through the process of exporting the chart to Power Point or Word.
