The new password requirements will be:

- * At least 8 characters
- * Includes both upper and lower case letter
- * At least 1 number
- * At least 1 special character (\$ @ ! % * ? &)

ACE 8.0 Service Pack 2 - Warning: Do not copy/paste rows with overrides (8 Dec 2020)

Date: 12/08/2020 Application: ACE

Version: 8.0 Service Pack 2

Problem: Copying and pasting a row that has case overrides applied causes the

application to crash.

Workaround: Remove all overrides before copying/pasting that particular row.

Note: you can export all cases with overrides to an xml file if you would like to save them for a later import.

Solution: A fix will be added to the ACE-to-ACE plugin release set for early January, 2021. When that release is available, download and install.
