#### Converting older ACE sessions to ACE version 7.0

One of ACE 7.0's new features includes a new file format. Instead of the .acw extension that has been in existence since version 4.0, ACE sessions now have an .aceit extension. The new .aceit file in a compressed XML format. Older ACE sessions (going all the way back to DOS) can be converted to the new format by opening the session using ACE 7.0.

A cost estimator faces many challenges when building a cost estimate. Challenges such as defining the WBS, implementing appropriate estimating methods, incorporating results from 3rd party applications, adjusting for inflation, including the impact of learning, documenting, phasing over time, modeling uncertainty, assessing alternatives, and of course creating engaging and informative reports, charts, documents, and PowerPoint presentations make this a daunting effort. For over 20 continuous years, the DoD has invested in the development of ACEIT so that these activities can be accomplished in a standard and structured manner. This presentation will show how the new features in ACEIT 7.0, to be released in early Fall 2006, enable the user to rapidly build standardized cost models.

### **Using Automation to Build Integrated Cost Estimates** Tina Elia and Darren Elliott, authors

This presentation will demonstrate how the Automated Cost Estimator (ACE) has been modified in ACEIT 6.1 and 7.0 (scheduled release in the fall of 2006) to establish direct links into other parametric cost estimating models and other COTS systems. We will demonstrate dynamic interfaces between an ACE-based cost model, the PRICE-H/PRICE-HL models, SEER-SEM/SEER-H models, and the NAFCOM model. To illustrate the ability to dynamically link cost and schedule information the ACE plug-in for Microsoft Project will also be demonstrated. Additionally, we will demonstrate how to leverage ACEIT technology via the ACEIT API to build custom cost estimating applications.

### **Prediction Interval Analysis for Non-Linear Equations** Dr. Shu-Ping Hu, author

This paper examines the proposed prediction intervals for different functional forms and methods, including the Minimum-Unbiased-Percentage Error (MUPE) regression methodology. Since the USCM8 CERs were developed using MUPE, we can apply this analytic approach to generate the corresponding Pls for the cost uncertainty analysis. This approach is also validated for the OLS models.

## **New ACEIT Basic 7.0 Training**

To complement the changes to the ACEIT 7.0 software we are updating our training courses and materials. For our new Basic course we have revised our course example WBS to focus on current modeling practices. We have improved the flow of the course to focus on eight major areas: Setting up an estimate Structure, Building Methodology Implementation, Building an Estimate, Entering Documentation, Model Revision and Debugging, 1<sup>st</sup> Level Model Automation, Using and Developing CERs, and Working with Estimate Results: Creating Estimate Excursions, Running Reports, and an introduction to Applying Cost Risk. The new course materials provide more detailed information on model implementation and best practices.
