Creating Custom Inflation Indices

Did you know that you can create custom inflation indices to use in your estimate? With the introduction of the Librarian in ACEIT 7.0, the task is easier than ever. With as little information as a fixed inflation rate, the Librarian can create a set of inflation indices that you can use in your ACE session. In addition, you can enter yearly escalation rates and outlay profiles and have the Librarian calculate the indices for you. ACEIT Highlight: 2007 Inflation Indices Now Available

The ACEIT 2007 Inflation tables have been published and are available for download on the <u>Inflation</u> <u>Indices Page</u> on aceit.com. The indices are based on the OSD guidance dated January 18, 2007. Indices for the Army, Navy, Air Force, USMC and Defense Agency have been updated. In addition, inflation indices for SOCOM have been added.

In general, out-year escalation has decreased for the majority of the appropriations. Additionally, outlay rates/profiles have also changed. This means that you will generally see a decrease in TY costs for your estimates. However, if your estimate is based on TY Throughputs, you may see an increase in your BY result.
