Tip of the Month – Reduce ACE Session File Size

Have you ever wondered what causes your ACE session file size to increase so quickly?

Aside from the obvious situations when you add many rows and/or columns to your session, there are two instances where your ACE session can grow in size quite substantially with seemingly little changes:

- Copying and pasting Power Point slides directly into the definition editor. A Power Point slide pasted into the ACE definition is approximately 200KB; a picture of a power point slide (e.g., a .bmp file) is about 20KB. Consequently, your ACE session can grow quite quickly when pasting numerous slides into the ACE documentation. We recommend pasting pictures instead of slides into the editor.
- ACE now stores Inputs/Results Viewer (IRV) results for what-if cases. What this means is that Base year and Then year results for every what-if case are now stored with the ACE session once those cases have been calculated in the IRV. Your ACE session can balloon if you have calculated multiple what-if cases. You can shrink your ACE session by selecting Calc > Clear Calculated Results from within the IRV.

Large ACE sessions can sometimes be problematic since they take a lot longer to both load and save. You will also notice performance issues during Autosave. You can adjust the frequency to Save Recovery File under Tools>User Options. We recommend using documentation techniques to reduce session size whenever possible.
