Tip of the Month – RI\$K On/Off

Did you know you can selectively turn RI\$K off for specific rows in your session?

ACE 7.3 contains a new column entitled **RI\$K On/Off** which allows you to include/exclude RI\$K specifications on the row during a RI\$K calculation. By default, the column is blank which corresponds to **On** or **1**. Simply type the word **Off** in the column or set it to **0** to temporarily ignore the RI\$K distribution. Another benefit is that the value can be a variable, so you can create whatif cases to turn RI\$K on or off on a row-by-row basis.

Terminology is important when we communicate to ensure that we all have the same understanding. We are continuing the "Terminology" section in the eNews for the next few months, to make sure we are all on the same page...so to speak!

CO\$TAT's new analysis feature called **Stepwise Analysis is** *not* **Stepwise Regression**. **Stepwise Regression** is an automatic procedure to find the best combination of independent variables to explain the variation in the dependent variable. It uses various methods to automatically make a selection about the independent variables without regard to if the variables logically make sense. It purely looks at the statistics.

Stepwise Analysis (in CO\$TAT) differs from Stepwise Regression because it requires more analyst input and direction. The user (rather than the software) selects which independent variables to evaluate and CO\$TAT examines each one and reports key statistical results for all the variables tested, allowing the user to select a CER to investigate further. At this point, the user can create a full regression report for that CER or perform another Stepwise Analysis to determine if adding yet another variable will improve the CER. Definitions for Stepwise Analysis and Stepwise Regression can be found in CO\$TAT help.
