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Tip of the Month

What is the FYPartialYear function and when would I use it?

The FYPartialYear function allows you to prorate a yearly value so that costs are reduced in partial years. You may be thinking, "Isn't that what the new FP phasing method does?" Yes it is, but only if the yearly cost is constant and prorating occurs in the first and last year of the range.

But, what if you have costs that change through the various phases of the program? For example:
